Our vision is for all young people to feel seen, valued and heard.

We deliver this through the power of youth work, giving young people space, voice and time to discover their passion and their purpose.

Carlisle was the first city in the country to establish a Youth Zone; a dedicated, purpose-built and unapologetically top notch space for our cities young people.

From the moment we opened our doors in 2011 right through to the present day, we have delivered on an unprecedented scale. Over the last year alone we have:

When the Youth Zone is full with young people, as it is 6 days and nights a week, 52 weeks a year, it becomes an incredible space; bursting with opportunity, fun and curiosity, where highly skilled youth workers get alongside young people on their own terms, building positive and trusted relationships which offer support, challenge and inspiration over the long term.

This combination of people and space creates a place of safety, reassurance and belonging, where young people are free to be themselves; to learn, grow and discover things about themselves and others throughout their childhood. Crucially, we are somewhere safe to go, with trusted adults to talk during times of difficulty or challenge; we show up for young people, reliably and consistently, especially for those who need us the most.

THE OFFER AND VISION OF CYZ

Many Young People value CYZ as their fun, safe place to go outside of school hours. Our mission with and for them is to harness the power of youth work so that young people have space, voice and time to discover their passion and purpose.

We have the benefit of a purpose built facility with a wide range of facilities and resources. Our universal youth offer of 7 Youth Clubs a week, 52 weeks a year, acts as the gateway through which young people can build the trusted relationships with our Youth Workers that when combined with a breadth of activities including arts, music, sports, cooking and enterprise, ensure our programme is educative, expressive, participative, inclusive and empowering.

Complementary to this universal offer is our Targeted Youth Engagement support, delivering a range of focused programmes including Young Carers, LGBTQ+ Youth Committee, Mentoring, Green Social Prescribing and Holiday Activity and Food programmes. Our programmes consistently achieve measurable impact across confidence, emotional wellbeing, social skills, aspirations, and physical and mental health - generating £17 of social value in terms of young people's wellbeing for every £1 invested.

VACANCY DETAILS

Carlisle Youth Zone has over 3000 individual Young People attending every year, and they are all unique in personalities and interests. Each one of them deserves the best.

We are currently recruiting for the following positions:

YOUTH WORKERS (CENTRE BASED OR DIGITAL

Part time: Contracted hours and bank work available). £12.60 per hour

Young People's interests change and update all the time, and it's important that as a Youth Work Team, we adapt also. Current interests of Young People attending CYZ include; cooking, gaming, sports, arts and crafts.

We are also looking for Youth Workers to join our Digital Youth Provision, where Young People will meet online. If you had a specific gaming focus this would be benefecial, but not essential for this session. Although this work is digital, you will deliver this from the CYZ building.

CLEANER

part Time: from 2.5hrs per week to 12.5hrs considered. £12.60

This role is a morning based position and you will work as part of s small cleaning and maintenance team to ensure CYZ is ready for the day ahead and that Young People attending have access to a clean, safe space daily.

CATERING COORDINATOR

Part Time: up to 19 hours per week for the right candidate £13.34 per hour

The right candidate will oversee all catering provision in CYZ. This will mean stock oversight, food hygiene standards, It combines a mix of cafe management, with delivery to Young People - a perfect balance!



CYZ AS AN EMPLOYER

Alongside being a Real Living Wage employer, there are a range of other benefits as being part of Team CYZ:

Holidays: 25 days plus 8 bank holidays (pro-rata)

Pension: eligible to join the CYZ NEST Pension Scheme (with 6% employer contribution where applicable)

Learning and Development: team development days, menu of training course, qualifications PLUS support via the OnSide Talent Academy

Wellbeing: employee support including Medicash Assistance Programme and access to CYZ gym and fitness facilities (when not in use by young people)

Family: discounted holiday club spaces for children and close family members
